Ranching Heritage Breeders are those that breed and raise the ranch-type horse, which remains at the core of the American Quarter Horse Association and epitomizes the breed's versatility.



GUIDELINES FOR APPLICATION

Applicant must be a current AQHA member.

Ranch remuda must consist of registered American Quarter Horses.

Ranch must

- own a minimum of five AQHA-registered mares used to produce ranch horses.
- maintain a remuda for the specific purpose of operating a working cattle ranch.
- have received, at minimum, an AQHA 10-year Breeder award.
- apply to and be approved by the AQHA Ranching Council.
- **pay a \$10 annual fee** to maintain status as a Ranching Heritage Breeder.
